

Suggested packing List of Clothes & Items

1. Your child's clothing is laundered once a week. It is picked up and will be returned to him/her the next day. You should provide approximately one and a half week's worth of clothing and several days extra in the event that unusual circumstances occur.
2. Use this check-off list as a guide, adjustments may be made to provide for your child's individual interests and needs.
3. Our washers and dryers are commercial machines. We recommend that delicate clothing not be sent to the camp laundry.
4. Luggage is transported to camp with your child. Please use only duffel bags or suitcases. (Limit two per camper.)
5. Remember everyone tends to overpack, be careful.
6. All items should be labeled with camper's name.
